



## 2020 Worksite Wellness Challenge: COVID-19 Response Pop-up Points System

**Purpose:** This is an additional incentive to increase your team’s 2020 Worksite Wellness Challenge score while addressing COVID-19 and infectious disease response in the Pop-Up Points System (PUPS). These additional COVID-PUPS will be awarded based on a “yes” answer to the COVID-19 related questions listed below and will be added to the team’s final score for the 2020 Worksite Wellness Challenge. The maximum number of COVID-PUPS a team can earn is **SIX POINTS**. Coaches are responsible for tracking their team’s participation, collecting proof of completion as necessary, and reporting it on the monthly Coach’s Report.

**ONE POINT per question, up to SIX total bonus points**

During the challenge, your company has supported or promoted local business’s response to COVID-19.	Example: host a food drive, volunteer to help distribute goods, making fabric masks or gather other PPE to donate or distribute.	1	
Your company provides COVID-19 resources and tools for mental and emotional health to support employees and their family (stress, anxiety, physical and financial health).
